INTRODUCTION

The Maryland Oral Health Resource Guide is developed by the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Office of Oral Health. The purpose of this guide is to inform and assist children, adults, patients with special health needs, caregivers, consumer groups, and government agencies in finding affordable and appropriate dental care services in Maryland and the immediate surrounding regions. Only those programs or public facilities which provide discounted or special dental services (e.g., homebound/bed bound patients) are listed in this directory. There is no intent to advertise or promote any particular dental practitioner, program, or service.

The guide is organized by county/ jurisdiction. Not all local jurisdictions have dental providers. If there are no services listed in your area, many of the programs in Baltimore City will treat patients from outside the city limits. It is also important to review the eligibility requirements and services provided for each program before scheduling an appointment. If a program lists a sliding fee scale payment option, ask what documentation is needed in order to receive the reduced fees.

Our intent is to update this dental resource guide periodically since programs, services and eligibility requirements can change rapidly. While every attempt has been made to ensure the accuracy of this information, we cannot be responsible for all details contained in this publication.

We hope that the Maryland Oral Health Resource Guide is of assistance in finding the appropriate dental care that you, your client, or family needs.

DEFINITIONS

- **Bedbound** - those confined to or unable to get out of bed without assistance.
- **Comprehensive dental services** - dental services including prevention, periodontal, restorative, endodontic and oral surgery.
- **Craniofacial anomalies** - atypical conditions of the head and face, especially as a result of hereditary or congenital defects.
- **Endodontics** - root canal treatment.
- **Extractions** - pulling a tooth or teeth.
- **Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC)** - a comprehensive primary care provider that offers care to all persons regardless of their ability to pay and is governed by a consumer dominated board of directors.
- **General dentistry** - dental services including dental hygiene, preventive, restorative and simple oral surgery.
- **Grey area** - those not eligible for Medicaid and without private insurance.
- **Homebound** - those confined to or unable to leave home without assistance.
- **Maternity** - pregnant.
- **Medicaid** - government health insurance program for income eligible children and adults.
- **Medically compromised** - health conditions that require special attention when receiving dental or surgical services.
- **Maryland Qualified Health Center (MQHC)** - a non-profit health center that provides the same scope of services as a FQHC (Federally Qualified Health Center) and offers discounted fees to the low income and uninsured.
- **Oral Surgery** - surgical procedures in the mouth, such as pulling of teeth.
- **Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery** - complex surgical procedures involving the mouth, head and neck regions.
- **Preventive Services** - x-rays, fluoride treatments, sealants.
- **Restorative services** - fillings and dentures.
- **Sliding fee scale** - treatment fees vary based on financial resources.

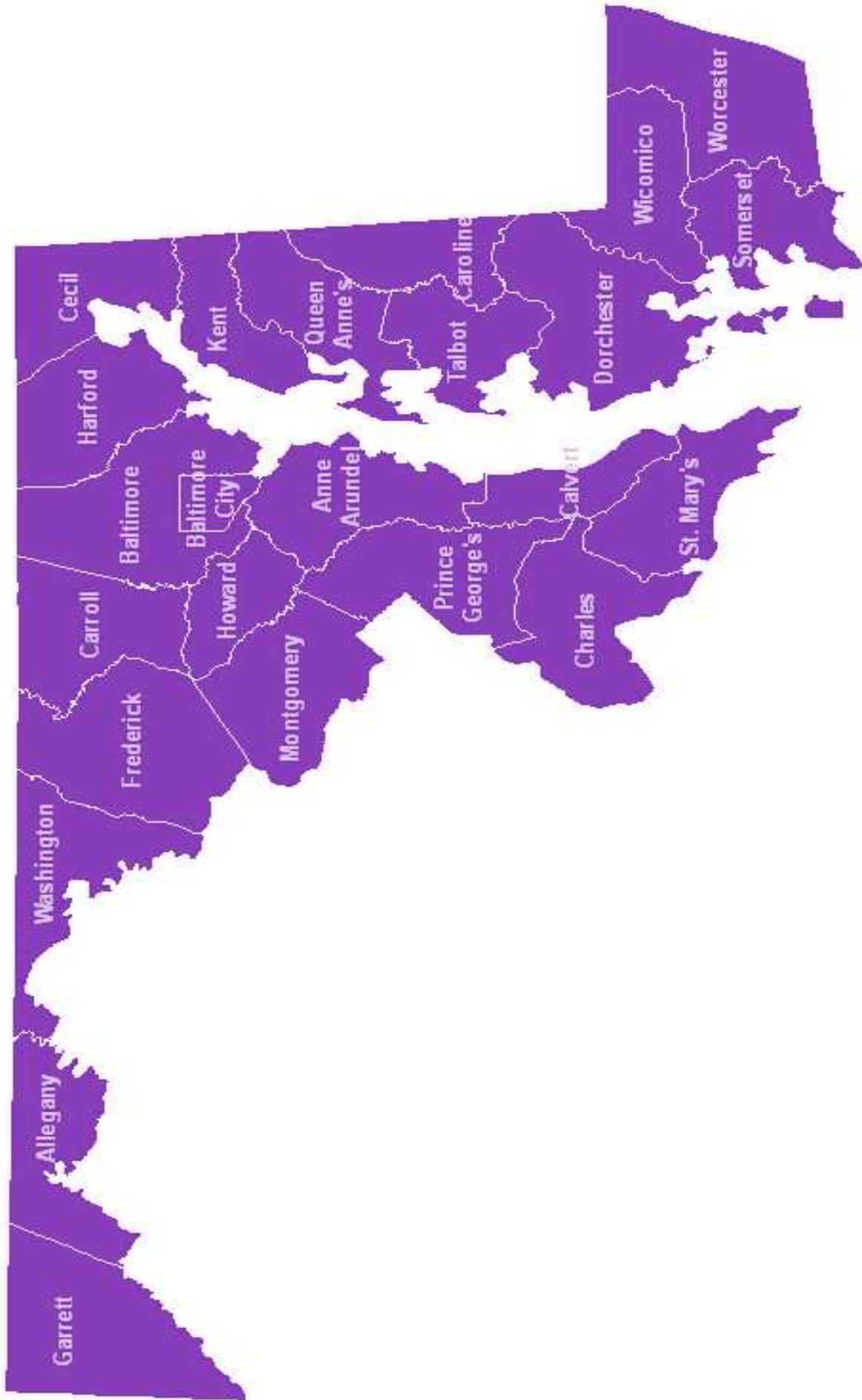
